Purpose:

2. Remove the word "incoming" to clear up the ambiguity of the composition of the Commodores Ball Committee.

ARTICLE VIII - COMMITTEES

SECTION (7) COMMODORE'S BALL COMMITTEE

- (a) The Commodore's ball committee shall consist of the immediate past Commodore and Vice Commodore as co-chairpersons plus the incoming Commodore and any members selected by the co-chairpersons. All members of the committee shall be kept equally informed of all pertinent information regarding the ball; i.e., the number and names of persons attending.
- (b) The Commodore's ball may be held between the dates of January 1st and March 31st with the approval of the membership.
- (c) The incoming Commodore will be given a choice of three locations. The selection is to be voted on by the membership. The incoming Commodore will choose the master of ceremonies and the color for the flower arrangements for the ball. (d) The committee shall render written reports and statements of income and expenses at the next meeting following the affair.
- (e) It shall be their duty to make ready for the installation of new officers by the change of watch in November.

ARTICLE VIII - COMMITTEES
